Country work - meal allowance	\$11.26 per meal
First aid allowance	\$0.55 per hour up to a maximum of \$20.83 per week
First aid kit reimbursement	reimbursement for the cost of maintaining a first aid kit
Fumigation depot allowance	\$9.14 for each day such work is performed
Verminous/decomposed human body allowance	\$117.50 on each occasion
Leading hand - in charge of 2-10 employees - payment in	\$1.03 per hour up to a maximum of \$39.20 per week
addition to the minimum wage for the highest classification
